

**Sonora High School Band Boosters

COW CHIP BINGO Rules and Regulations**

1. Bingo field will be a 50 x 60 yard field located at Sonora High School.
2. Each square yard represents a “land deed parcel” (total of 3000), which corresponds to each number ticket (0001 to 3000)
3. Each “land deed parcel” (ticket) requires a \$5.00 donation.
5. All parcels are numbered at random by computer prior to starting. A chart will display the parcels during the Cow Chip Bingo Game.
6. At 11:00am on May 11, 2013, three cows will be released onto the marked 50 x 60 yard field.
7. The first three “plops” are measured and recorded.
8. Once each parcel has been located on the corresponding numbered chart, the winnings are paid as follows:
 - * The first “plop” wins \$250.00
 - * The second “plop” wins \$500.00
 - * The third “plop” wins \$750.00
- *Prize amounts are based on 3,000 tickets being sold. If all tickets are not sold then winning prizes will equal 10% of total sales of per the State of California non-profit rules.
9. If the “cow chip” lands on bordering parcels (on the line), the prize money will be divided equally among the owners of all affected parcels regardless of the volume on each parcel.
10. If the “cow chip” lands on an unsold lot, the measurement will move one lot north and clockwise until we find a winner.
11. Winners need not be present to win. Must be over 21 to receive prize money.
