FROM February 3, 2015

Call to order:

- President Rivers called the meeting to order at 6:05 pm.

President's Report:

- Welcome parents to our monthly Band Boosters meeting!
- With the parades coming to an end, the FJUHSD has been sending our organization invoices for the bus use and transportation. I am anticipating these invoices will total around \$3000.00, so I would like to start another fundraiser to prepare us for paying these invoices. With the approval of our board of officers and booster club members, I would like to pay two of the four outstanding invoices this month.
- I was thinking of using See's Candies for this fundraiser, for Valentine's Day is approaching. I soon learned that See's likes all processed orders in 2 – 3 weeks before the desired pickup date, so that would only leave us about three good days to sell candy. I think at this time a Popcorn Palace fundraiser would be more feasible for us; and more info to come shortly when I have finished all of the research for this fundraiser.
- We are working on some tentative dates of return for our Blue Marching Uniforms. Once we have this information, it will be emailed and copies will be sent home with our students.

Treasurer's Report:
