Call to order:

- President Rivers called the meeting to order at 7:12 pm.

Minutes:

Treasurer's Report:

- We have made three deposits this month. All of our outstanding invoices have been paid, including the locks purchased for the Lock Fundraiser. We earned approximately \$ 1400.00

Director's Report:

- We will be continuing our after school rehearsals on Tuesdays, from 3:30 pm to 7:00 pm.
- Home football games on the next two Fridays, September 5th and 12th. Our home games are held at La Habra HS, and the call times are at 5:30 pm at the stadium for our students, and at 5:00 pm to help with loading and transporting our large instruments from Sonora HS to LHHS. We will be using the Blue Uniforms for the football games. Students will need black tube socks, black shoes, and can wear shorts and a t-shirt underneath their uniform. Students can change into their uniform at LHHS, and we normally do this by the racquetball courts. After we are in uniform, we will go to the basketball courts to practice before we march onto the field for the National Anthem. We will continue our Pizza Party fundraiser tradition by attending Pepz Pizza right after the game.
- White Uniform sizing will be occurring this month to prepare for our first parade in October. We can use some volunteers to help us with this. Blue Uniforms will go home with our students, but the White Uniforms stay on campus.
- We will be sending a set of our water bottles home with our students for filling. This will give our students something to drink before and during the games.
- College night will be this September 25th. It will begin at 7:00 pm.
- If our band and color guard parents would like to volunteer and help at the games, it would be a great idea if our parents could wear band shirts so they could blend in with the band and the band boosters. Please order the apparel through Mr. Diebolt so it can be processed through the boosters.
- We are still waiting to hear if our Grant we applied for last semester has been approved. If we are awarded this grant, we can update our antiquated instruments an equipment, and purchased a

haulage vehicle for our equipment to the games and parades. Most important, we can research into updating our uniforms.

Officer's Report:

The proper use of socks while wearing the uniform should be logo free, mid-calf style; black socks for the blue uniform, and white socks for the white uniform.
- **Fundraising:** Our normal fundraisers will be starting soon. Our fundraisers help support the band and color guard with costs associated with parades, entry fees, uniforms, band supplies, etc. Since the band boosters club is a 501 (c) (3) non-profit corporation, all donations made through the suggested band "fair share" semester programs are tax deductible.
